Here are just a few examples of its appearance:

- 40 days of rain during the flood of Noah
- 40 years Moses spent wandering in the desert
 - *40 years he was a Shepherd
 - *40 years he led Israel
- 40 days the spies searched out the Promised Land
- 40 years of wilderness, wandering in the desert, when Israel was disobedient
- 40 days the prophet Elijah spent in the cave waiting on word from God
- 40 days the prophet Ezekiel laid on his side symbolizing the sins of Israel
- 40 days Jonah preached repentance before God would destroy Nineveh
- 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness in prayer and fasting tempted by Satan after his Baptism
- 40 days Jesus appeared to his disciples between Easter and the Ascension

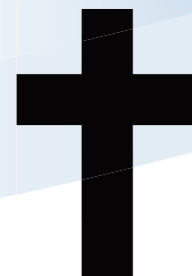

Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten Season, is observed six and one half weeks before Easter. It is a day of fast and abstinence when ashes are blessed and imposed on the foreheads of the faithful to remind us of our obligation to do penance of sins, to seek spiritual renewal by means of prayer, fasting, good works and by bearing with patience the trials and difficulties of everyday life. The ashes are used to mark the forehead with the Sign of the Cross, with the reminder: "Remember you are dust, and to dust you will return."

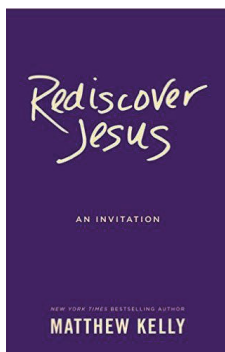

I pray God's outpouring of grace upon all of us during Lent as we journey to greater intimacy and communion with the Lord.

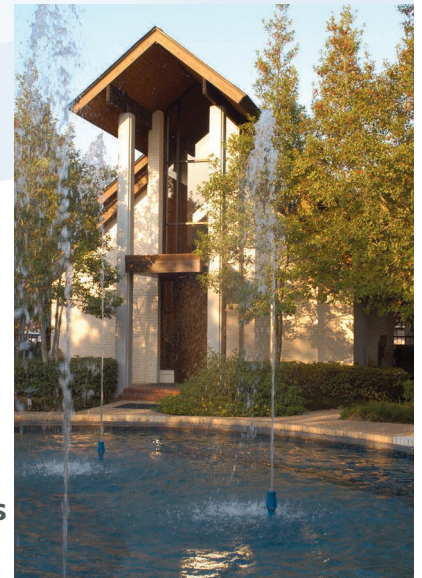
May these 40 days help us to meditate on Jesus' great love for us in giving Himself on the cross and may He give us strength to carry our crosses in union with Him.

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

The Divine Mercy Novena began **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 21** with 6:00 pm Mass followed by the sung Chaplet and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, and continues for nine Tuesdays in preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy.

St. Faustina Kowalska, a simple Polish nun who in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. The message is nothing new for Catholics, but is a reminder of what the Church has always taught through Scripture and Tradition: that God is merciful and forgiving and that we too must show mercy and forgiveness. In the Divine Mercy devotion, the message takes on a powerful new focus, calling people to a deeper understanding that God's love is unlimited and available to everyone - especially the greatest of sinners.

The message of Divine Mercy is that God loves us - all of us - no matter how great our sins. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others, sharing His joy. The devotional practices revealed through St. Faustina were given to us as "vessels of mercy" through which God's love can be poured out upon the whole world.
