The 48th annual Spring Festival, was a great occasion to honor two outstanding individuals who have played critical roles in building the Mercy community we enjoy today. At that festival, we inducted Ms. Carolyn Guidry and Ms. Jerri Trahan into the Our Lady of Mercy Hall of Fame.

It could certainly be said that these individuals are the embodiment of the phrase "<u>WE ARE MERCY</u>." Everything they accomplished here was a testament to their desire to make Our Lady of Mercy what we affectionately know as, The Pearl of Mid City!

Serving in their respective roles as Principal and Administrative Assistant, both considered their positions more than just "jobs." They set the bar high for others who followed as to how things "should be done."

Ms. Carolyn Guidry joined Our Lady of Mercy as Principal in 1995 as new buildings on campus were completed with the goal of preparing our students for the new millennium. An experienced educator, Carolyn's "hands on" and "lead by example" attitude embodied her many gifts and talents. She entrenched herself into the Mercy culture all while being a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and volunteer of numerous church ministries.

Carolyn's vision of integrating technology throughout the school campus was such an outstanding measure of her legacy here. She endlessly sought every resource available to make educational tools a reality, not only for students, but the faculty and staff as well. Her attention to the rapid growth of technology motivated her dream of portable lap top carts, wi-fi, the first Mercy website (which she created), and many other aspects that eventually set the stage for

our current resources - the Apple lab, iPads and Smart Boards that we utilize today.

Our second inductee, Ms. Jerri Trahan, was tremendously gifted in orchestrating team efforts among her colleagues and parent volunteers! Perhaps part of her success in bringing people together was a result of serving in various roles throughout



her Mercy career. Ms. Trahan truly knew the details of every duty - not only because she created them, but because she experienced them . . . clerical, development director, admissions director, extended day director, events coordinator, Uplift chairperson, tutor, maintenance supervisor, administrative assistant . . . and the list goes on! One of her many roles was planning and implementing the details of the Hall of Fame event, the same event at which she was posthumously honored. She held a number of titles throughout her extended career, but most importantly she answered to wife, mom, and her favorite title, Mimi!

Jerri definitely knew how to get people involved in a project, but she never hesitated to jump in feet first to accomplish a mission. Certainly not intending to turn a joyous occasion to one of sadness, but it bears stating that Jerri's long battle with cancer was met with the same fierce determination with which she met all tasks - head on and filled with faith. Many times, this determination allowed for very little rest. In October 2015, God called her home to be with Him. Surely she was with us on that day as we remembered the beautiful legacy she has left for Mercy, her family, friends, and colleagues.

#### **PRIESTLY ORDINATION - MAY 27, 2017**

#### Fr. Ryan Hallford

Fr. Ryan Hallford admits that he heard God's calling at an early age in life. Fr. Hallford originally entered St. Joseph Seminary after completing his freshman year at LSU in 2003. After enduring two years of enthusiastic study, Hurricane Katrina hit the Greater New Orleans area, forever changing the landscape and psyche of southeast Louisiana. At that time, Hallford left the seminary with no intention of returning. He simply lost the desire to become a priest.



He returned to LSU and graduated with a degree in philosophy. He spent several years teaching theology at local Baton Rouge Catholic Schools with the goal of eventually becoming a college professor. But God had a different plan for Hallford. As God so often does, once He plants a seed, although it may remain dormant for some time, it never dies.

A few life changing events and a pilgrimage to Spain's Camino de Santiago became the catalyst for Hallford to reconsider the priesthood. With praise and thanksgiving, this weekend Fr. Ryan Hallford along with Fr. Pat Broussard will joyfully enter the priesthood of Jesus Christ.

Fr. Hallford will celebrate his first Masses here at Our Lady of Mercy on Saturday, May 27th at 4:00 pm and Sunday, May 28th at 10:30 am.

#### Fr. Pat Broussard

Fr. Pat Broussard's path to priestly ordination has a unique twist. Several years ago when his wife suddenly passed, the then permanent deacon was faced with likely the toughest decision of his life - remain a celibate deacon, be laicized and remarry, or consider the "remote possibility of become a priest." Fr. Broussard is joining a trend of priests being ordained later in life. Fr. Eddie Martin who was ordained last year shares a similar spiritual journey as Fr. Broussard. With the blessing of his mother-in-law whom he loves and respects, the call to priesthood became more clear and the seeds for a pastoral ministry had been planted.


