MAGNIFYING THE FAITHFUI

Have you ever considered being a teacher in the Parish School of Religion? It will be one of the most fulfilling volunteer activities you might spend one hour a week doing. It is hard to believe that I began over twenty years ago; Fr. Michael Moroney was pastor and Ms. Kathy Screen was Director of Religious Education. Sometimes I had classes of only two or three students, and sometimes 15. Every class was different, just as every child is different, but they all taught me so much about my faith. That is right - they taught me.

Faith is something that is so personal that you can get to know your students very well, even though you only meet once a week. Some of them know a lot about our Catholic religion, and some of them know very little. Learning about the Bible and how to use it, opens their eyes to the wonderful stories it contains; some they have heard before, and some they can't believe are in a religious book! To learn that the heroes in the Bible were not perfect people, but people just like us, opens their eyes to knowing that God wants all of us to be His heroes. Some of those Bible stories help us to remember what happens when people don't do what God wants them to do, but it also shows the lengths He will go to rescue His people when they are in trouble!

If you can remember the old TV show "Kids Say the Darndest Things," then you can only imagine some of the discussions we have had about why certain things are sinful when people all over are doing them. The world we live in has warped our values into thinking if it is on TV and in the movies, it must be normal and okay. Not only learning the Ten Commandments but breaking them down into all the "sub-topics" that fall under those commandments, e.g. hitting your brother or sister, sassing your mom, cheating on a test, and on and on, helps them relate sins to everyday life. They bring up things I have never thought about.

The first year that I taught, the book opened with a prayer: "Jesus, the Good Shepherd, watch over me today. Help me follow where You lead and never go astray." I have taught it to every class. Each year I have tried to emphasize that we are just like those dumb sheep that wander off and get into all manner of trouble, and yet God continues to seek us out and bring us back into the safety of His arms. Talking to them about how much God loves us and wants us to be happy with Him, has made me focus on my own relationship with God. Sharing your faith makes it grow much stronger. Jesus loves me, yes I know!

A Letter From the Pastor

As school celebrates its last day and summer vacation begins, I want to share a few things that are on my mind as we settle into the long, hot days of summer.

FIRST, I want to express how exciting it was to finally break ground on the new Early Childhood Development Center. The celebration with Bishop Muench, along with so many of our faculty and school children present, made for a truly beautiful occasion. Coleman Partners Architects have done a beautiful design for this state of the art facility and the lowest bidder on the project was Arkel Construction, owned by our own faithful parishioners, Johnny and Rose Marie Fife. Parishioners are now seeing activity which includes the leveling of the Polito House next to the PAC for a new parking lot and the taking down of the brown brick Caruso home to make room for the new Early Childhood Center addition.



SECOND, I want to remind everyone that it is not too late to do something for the <u>Traditions for Tomorrow Capital Campaign</u>. As of now - of the 3100 registered families at Mercy, 1004 families have participated. These families have given generously what they could ... some more than others but this campaign is about equal sacrifice not equal amounts. As you know, I asked each family in the parish to consider a gift of \$5,000.00 over three years. I do realize that this is too great a sum for many families especially with children in school or those on fixed incomes. But, I would still ask that everyone do <u>something</u>. I would even propose \$19.48 per month for the next three years - why \$19.48 - because 1948 was the year Our Lady of Mercy was founded. If we all do something, we can accomplish a tremendous future for our children and the strong presence of the Catholic Church in our community.

<u>THIRD</u>, I know that many are waiting the addition of the <u>columbarium garden</u> (burial place for cremains). Preparations are continuing and Parish Administrator Randy Arabie is anticipating action on this desirable addition in the early fall. Stay tuned for an informational meeting.

FOURTH, Our parish is foremost a place of prayer and worship. Please be mindful that during the summer months Adorers are always needed in the Adoration Chapel. As I have shared earlier this year - the Chapel cannot remain open 24 hours / 7 days a week without faithful committed Adorers. During these summer months when many are away - Adorers are needed. If you are able to give an hour of your time to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, I ask that you call Martha Wells at (225) 928-5157. Give yourself to Jesus in Adoration. Those who take the difficult early morning hours receive much grace for your sacrifice. Jesus says to each of us, "I WAIT FOR YOU."



FIFTH, July is the "slowest" month at Mercy - if one can even use that word "slow" in the same breath with Mercy. Fr. Joey Aguilar from the Philippines will be returning to be with us while I take a little rest and relaxation. I am so grateful to the Filipino Prayer Group and Couples for Christ for their particular goodness and hospitality to Fr. Joey.

SIXTH, I want to thank everyone who has been so generous to the youth who participated in the Haiti Mission Trip! I am so humbled by those who have supported our young people. I want to thank our Youth Director Amelia Gallagher who has done an exceptional job of working with our young people. Their lives will be forever changed after their Haiti experience in realizing how blessed each of them are. Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and several years ago experienced a devastating earthquake. Our Young people will be forever changed. Thank you - all who are the Haiti Mission benefactors.



<u>SEVENTH</u>, As you can see, none of us can simply wait for someone else to do what needs to be done. Mercy is Mercy because of <u>you</u>, the faithful parishioners and families. When you cease to do what you do - Mercy will cease to be what it has always been.

Fr. Nutan and I are appointed by Bishop Muench to serve. Pray for us to be good servants and shepherds.

I pray everyone will have a wonderful summer. While you are away on vacation - don't forget to keep Mercy between your light and water bill.


