Serve the Needs of All: "Whoever wishes to be first among you will be the servant of all" MARK 10:44

Dear Faithful Parishioner,

Jesus preached a Gospel of hope and repentance. So did the disciples. Jesus healed the sick. So did the disciples. Jesus made the lame walk and the blind see. So did the disciples. Jesus cast out unclean spirits, and the disciples did too. They did what Jesus did because He gave them the power and authority to do so. And then, in great humility, Jesus washed their feet and commanded them to do the same.

In the latter years of His earthly ministry, Jesus did even more. And, following the Lord's Ascension, the disciples did as well – preaching to thousands, restoring the blind and lame, healing the sick, even raising the dead. Jesus gave them authority, Jesus granted them special ability, and then – at Pentecost, with the coming of the Holy Spirit – everyone who identified with the faith was afforded spiritual gifts that they might serve others, for the common good. "To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." 1 CORINTHIANS 12:7

Maybe your gifts are demonstrative and public – you lead committees, you teach, you proclaim sacred Scripture at Mass, or you direct the building of new facilities. Your gifts could also be demonstrated with few even knowing about it: you mentor a troubled teen, you visit the sick in the hospital, you send notes of encouragement, or you set up chairs long before others arrive. At MERCY, ministry roles are almost too numerous to count. Thanks to hundreds and hundreds of faithful parishioners, the work is done and done well to the glory of God the Father. There is certainly a role for you. Just like the blessed Apostles and other first century servants, God has gifted you to serve Him, your fellow Catholics, and all those who look to our parish – church and school – for direction, nurture and assistance. # A CALL TO SERVE THE **NEEDS OF ALL**


I urge you, therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship.

As in one body we have many parts, and all the parts do not have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another.

Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us exercise them: if prophecy, in proportion to the faith; if ministry, in ministering; if one is a teacher, in teaching; if one exhorts, in exhortation; if one contributes, in generosity; if one is over others, with diligence; if one does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness.

Do not grow slack in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord.

"Do you realize what I have done for you? You call me 'teacher' and 'master,' and rightly so, for indeed I am. If I, therefore,

# Love is service.

It is serving others. For example, after the washing of the feet Jesus explained the gesture to the Apostles, He taught that we are made to serve one another, and if I say that I love but I don't serve the other, don't help the other, don't enable him to go forward, don't sacrifice myself for him, this isn't love.

"You have carried the Cross... there is the sign of love. That history of God's love involved in works and dialogue, with respect, with forgiveness, with patience during so many centuries of history with His people, ends there—His Son on the Cross, the greatest service, which is giving one's life, sacrificing oneself, helping others. It's not easy to speak of love, it's not easy to experience love."


# We Follow Christ Modeling His Love WE SERVE IN OUR PARISH
