



RELIC OF POPE ST. JOHN PAUL II

Public veneration of a first class blood relic of Pope Saint John Paul II is scheduled to visit Our Lady of Mercy on Friday, November 3rd.

The popular Pope Saint John Paul II was the Pontiff for 27 years-from 1978 to 2005, making him the second longest-serving Pope in modern history after Pope Pius IX. He was also the most widely traveled Pope in history, visiting 129 countries during his pontificate.



Pope Saint John Paul II was born on May 18, 1920 in Wadowice, Poland, and was ordained a priest in 1946. In 1958, he became the bishop of Ombi and later the archbishop of Krakow in 1964.

He died at the age of 84 at the Vatican on April 2, 2005, the vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday.

Pope Saint John Paul II was beatified on May 1, 2011, also Divine Mercy Sunday, at Saint Peter's Square by his immediate successor, Pope Benedict XVI.

He was canonized on April 27, 2014, again a Divine Mercy Sunday, together with Pope John XXIII.

He is the patron saint of World Youth Day and the World Meeting of Families, with his feast day celebrated on the anniversary of his papal inauguration on Oct. 22.

A vile of liquefied blood of Pope St. John Paul II will be available for public veneration on Friday, November 3rd at Our Lady of Mercy. This relic is traveling with the Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary from Miami, Florida. More details to follow in the coming weeks.
