MERCY ACTS RETREAT

The Solomon Center

Women's Retreat - May 24th - 27th

By now, you've probably heard some chattering by fellow parishioners about something called an ACTS Retreat and maybe have even been invited or encouraged to attend such a retreat. Also in that same conversation, the acquaintance who was telling you about the retreat probably didn't reveal much other than, "you just have to go and experience it!" So what exactly is entailed in an ACTS Retreat?

An ACTS Retreat is a three-night Catholic lay retreat presented by fellow parishioners. The retreat begins on a Thursday evening as retreatants gather at the sponsoring parish [Mercy] for a short send-off ceremony. Retreatants are then transported to a retreat facility [The Solomon Center] for the rest of the weekend. The retreat ends Sunday as the full team of retreat participants and team leaders return to Our Lady of Mercy for a welcome Mass at 12:00 noon celebrated with the parish community followed by a simple reception.

Talks and activities during the retreat focus on Adoration, Community, Theology and Service, from which the ACTS program acronym is derived. Holy Scripture and the teachings of the Catholic Church are the guides for the retreats, although one does not have to be Catholic to attend. The retreat takes on the traditions and atmosphere of the parish community sponsoring it. The retreat facilitates the attainment of a new or deeper relationship with the Lord through:

Adoration - the call by, acceptance of, and response to God

Community - the love and caring of each other

Theology - the study of God through Scripture and the Catholic Faith

Service - to God and His people

This results in a new or renewed dedication to the life of the parish community and a new recognition of the needs of those around us and of our obligation, as followers of Christ, to help meet those needs. The ACTS Retreat weekend brings the retreatants to a better understanding of God's love for them, and also develops their need to share that love with others through their involvement in a faith-centered parish community. It is a powerful community building experience and a powerful and enduring personal conversion experience.

Our Lady of Mercy parish has an upcoming women's retreat taking place on the beautiful grounds of the Solomon Center (www.solomoncenter.org) located in Loranger, Louisiana. Spots are available and registration is open on the homepage of the church website - www.olomchurch.com.

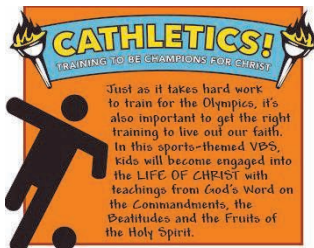

PARISH LIFE

Dear Parishioners,

I want to take the opportunity to share with everyone my thoughts and prayers as we continue this joyful celebration of the Easter Season! I express my joy in all of the wonderful things that have been taking place in the spiritual life of our parish particularly during the Lenten and Easter Seasons. I was so edified by the number of people who made daily Mass and the Tuesday Divine Mercy Novena part of their Lenten sacrifice and discipline. Our sung Divine Mercy Chaplet was so beautiful for the nine Tuesdays leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday. Looking out each day at the number of people attending daily Mass was most inspiring.

The Parish Mission with Deacon Harold Burke-Sivers was awesome and his words of encouragement to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation was a powerful motivation for many people to return to the sacrament after quite some time.

The celebration of the Easter Vigil and welcoming into our Catholic family the RCIA candidates was another particularly joyful experience. Our parish will be a better place to pray, worship, and serve one another because of these new Catholics. I want to thank Jason Romero of the RCIA Team for an outstanding job.

Needless to say, the incredible Mercy Choir under the awesome Music Ministry during Lent and Easter was outstanding. We are so blessed to have such talented voices to lead us in song and praise every Sunday. As many of you know the Choir Director, Mrs. Mary Kannenberg, is just beginning to return after having had a beautiful baby boy. Congratulations to Mary and Geoff Kannenberg. We missed you Mary and we are glad you are coming back soon.

On another very important note, I want to share with you that we are once again experiencing difficulty in filling early morning hours in the Adoration Chapel. As of late, this has been a constant challenge and I remind you that it is impossible for the Chapel to remain open 24 hours a day without committed adorers. Not long ago, there were 12 Adoration Chapels in our Diocese of which most of them were open 24 hours. Our Lady of Mercy Adoration Chapel now remains the only chapel open 24 hours. The Mercy Chapel is probably one of the oldest in the entire country outside a monastery or religious institution that has made adoration available 24 hours a day for over 35 years. At this point, the burden is becoming extremely difficult for a very few committed adorers and volunteers in the early morning hours. The Adoration

Chapel Coordinator, Martha Wells, does a remarkable job in seeing that these hours are presently filled, but this effort cannot continue for very much longer. Committed Adorers for the early morning hours are desperately needed and without them a decision will have to be made to close the Chapel from Midnight until 5:00 am. I ask your prayerful consideration in taking on the sacrifice of an early morning hour in prayer in the Adoration Chapel. Once again, without you it cannot be open 24 hours a day.

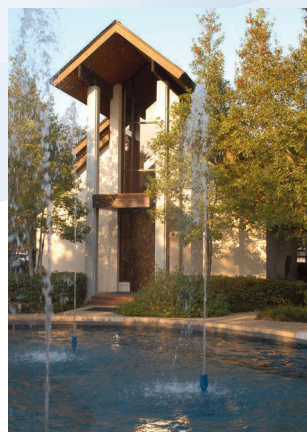
I am so happy to share with you again that Bishop Muench has granted permission for our parish to move forward with the construction of the new school gym. The gym will be built to the left of the present school gym which will be then renovated into a Music and Performing Arts Center. This ability to move seamlessly to gym construction will save our parish a significant amount of money. I am so grateful to Bishop Muench for the confidence he has shown in the leadership of our parish along with the energy, direction, and generosity of our faithful families.

The new 14 classroom building presently under construction will be completed by the end of May and students will be in the new building for the academic year beginning this August 2018. Obviously, none of this would be possible without the incredible generosity, sacrifice, and commitment of our Mercy families.

Words cannot express my gratitude to all of you who have supported this project. I remind you that it is not about equal giving but equal sacrifice. Everyone can do something! I am so humbled and overwhelmed by the goodness of the faithful Mercy families.

Finally, I want to say how beautiful it was to celebrate First Holy Communion with the 97 children in our parish. To all of the Religion Teachers and Catechists who did a great job, I am so grateful. The celebration of the Sacraments is our top priority and nowhere is it done more beautiful than in this Church dedicated to our Heavenly Mother Mary. May she watch over our children and keep them always close to Jesus.

I look forward to seeing everyone at the Fair and spending time together in friendship, fellowship, and community. **BE THERE OR BE SQUARE!**

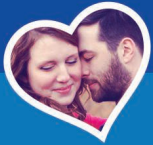

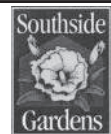
