
FEAST OF ST. PADRE PIO

Special 3:00 pm Mass on Sunday, September 23rd

Marking the 50th anniversary of his death and the 100th anniversary of his stigmata, Our Lady of Mercy will celebrate a special Mass for the Feast Day of St. Padre Pio of Pietrelcina with celebrant Fr. Steve Rodrigues, OFM, Cap.

Padre Pio was a friar, priest, stigmatist, and mystic, now venerated as a saint of the Catholic Church. Born Francesco Forgione, he was given the name of Pius (Italian: Pio)

when he joined the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin. Padre Pio became famous for his stigmata for most of his life. He was both beatified (1999) and canonized (2002) by Pope St. John Paul II. The Sanctuary of Saint Pio of Pietrelcina is located in San Giovanni Rotondo, Province of Foggia, Italy.
