Apostles' Creed

(L)I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary.

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

(R)I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Lord's Prayer

(L)Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed by thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is heaven.

(R)Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail Mary

(L)Hail Mary, full of grace; the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

(R)Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Glory Be

(L)Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

(R)As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

The Fatima Prayer

(A)O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.

Hail, Holy Queen

(L)Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, O most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet virgin Mary. Pray for us O holy mother of God.

(R)That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Legion of Mary Prayer

(A)O God, Whose only-begotten Son, by His life, death and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal salvation; grant, we beseech thee, that meditating upon these mysteries in the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what they promise. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.



The Mysteries of the Rosary

Joyful Mysteries Advent, February, July

- **The Annunciation:** The angel Gabriel announces to Mary that she is to become the Mother of Jesus.
- **The Visitation:** Mary visits and helps her cousin Elizabeth.
- **The Nativity:** Mary gives birth to Jesus in a stable in Bethlehem.
- **The Presentation in the Temple:** Jesus is presented in the Temple.
- **The Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple:** Jesus is found in the Temple and "all who heard Him were amazed."

Mysteries of Light / Luminous Mysteries January, June, October

- **The Baptism in the Jordan:** Jesus' public life begins when John baptizes him in the Jordan.
- **The Wedding Feast at Cana:** Jesus performs his first sign, turning water into wine.
- **The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God:** Jesus calls everyone to enter the Kingdom of God. Matthew
- **The Transfiguration:** Jesus briefly reveals his divine glory in the presence of Peter, John and James.
- **The Institution of the Eucharist:** The Passover meal receives a new meaning with the institution of the Eucharist, anticipating the glory of the Kingdom.

Sorrowful Mysteries Lent, March, August

- **The Agony in the Garden:** Jesus suffers his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane and overcomes temptation through prayer.
- **The Scourging at the Pillar:** Jesus is taken to Pilate and is mocked and whipped at the pillar.
- **The Crowning with Thorns:** Jesus is crowned with a circle of sharp thorns.
- **The Carrying of the Cross:** Jesus carries the cross to Golgotha.
- **The Crucifixion:** Jesus dies on the cross.

Glorious Mysteries Easter Season, May, November

- **The Resurrection:** Jesus rises from the dead on the third day.
- **The Ascension:** Jesus ascends into heaven forty days after resurrection.
- **The Descent of the Holy Spirit:** The Holy Spirit descends upon Mary and the apostles.
- **The Assumption:** Mary, Mother of God, was taken up into heaven body and soul.
- **The Crowning of Our Lady Queen of Heaven:** Mary is crowned Queen of heaven and earth.
