
HELP THOSE IN NEED IN OUR COMMUNITY!

COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATES

Every child deserves a family. No child should have to live with abuse or neglect, yet children continue to be removed from their homes and placed into foster care for their own protection.

As these children await safe, permanent homes, Capital Area CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) volunteers speak up for their best interests to help them reach forever families. CASA volunteers

are everyday people who give of their time and energy to make a difference in a child's future. There are over 100 foster kids on a waitlist waiting to be assigned a CASA volunteer.

Our congregation can help abused and neglected children by spreading the word about CASA and the need for volunteers in order to continue serving every child in East Baton Rouge Parish who needs a voice. <u>The next volunteer training course begins on January</u> <u>10th, 2022.</u> The small act of spreading the word can make a big difference.

Abused and neglected children need caring adults to speak up for them. You can help a child reach a safe, permanent home by becoming a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteer. Capital Area CASA needs volunteers to continue serving every child in our community who needs a voice. Brief orientation sessions are held weekly to provide more information.
