



HERE ARE ANSWERS TO THE MOST COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT THE MERCY FAIR.

WHAT ARE THE DATES OF THE 2023 FAIR?

The 2023 Our Lady of Mercy Fair is from Friday, April 28th through Sunday, April 30th.

WHERE CAN I BUY T-SHIRTS:

2023 Fair T-shirts can be ordered online. The shirt pre-order guarantees any order by April 15th. After that date, the remaining shirts will be available first-come first-served. Last day to order fair t-shirts through the website is Tuesday April 25th.

HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY ORDER I PLACED ONLINE?

If you selected classroom delivery, your order will be sent home with your child the week of April 24th.

If you selected Church Office pick-up, your order will be available for pick-up in the Our Lady of Mercy Parish Office Building beginning on Tuesday April 26th from 8:30am-4pm (3pm of Fridays).

WHERE CAN I BUY A RIDE ARMBAND:

Fair Weekend Armbands are on sale online! Armbands may be purchased online or at the fair ticket booth during Fair hours. You may choose to have your Mercy Student's armband put on them at school on Friday April 28th. All other armbands will be available for pick-up at the will- call booth during the Fair.

WHAT IF I DON'T NEED A RIDE-BAND FOR THE ENTIRE WEEKEND?

Day Armbands will also be for Sale at the Fair. \$40/day for 42" and up and \$30/day for riders below 42" tall. Ride Tickets may also be purchased at the fair for \$1/ticket in \$20 books. Rides require 4-7 tickets per ride. The armband includes unlimited rides for all rides during fair hours.

WHERE ARE THE FAIRGROUNDS LOCATED?

The Mercy Fair is located on the school's football field located on Marquette Ave. The fairgrounds are accessible from the entrance near the concession stand.

WHAT ARE DAILY ADMISSION PRICES?

Admission to the Our Lady of Mercy Fair is FREE for everyone.

WHAT ARE RIDE, FOOD AND BEVERAGE PRICES?

Prices of rides, games, food and beverages vary. Tickets and bracelets are available for purchase at the Ride Ticket Booth or online, both accepting cash and credit cards. Food and Beverage booths will accept Cash ONLY. Games will be CASH ONLY.

We will have an ATM on site with a traditional ATM fee. NO CHECKS WILL BE CASHED THE WEEKEND OF THE FAIR.

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE RAFFLE TICKETS?

We will again have our \$1000 Raffle and \$10,000. Raffle at the Mercy Fair. \$1000 Raffle books will be sent home with students in back pack mail and mailed to parishioners. Additional books may be picked up at the Church Office or by contacting mallory.anderson@olomchurch.com

CAN I BRING MY OWN FOOD/BEVERAGES TO THE FAIR?

Fairgoers should not bring food and drink. Plenty of great food and beverages will be sold throughout the weekend. Fairgoers will not be allowed to carry any alcoholic beverages or coolers onto campus. No glass bottles or containers will be allowed. Remember this is a fundraiser for our great Parish!

HOW DO I PURCHASE A FAMILY FAIR TENT?

After we satisfy our sponsorship allotment of Family Fair Tents, we will open a lottery to purchase remaining family fair tents. That lottery will open on Monday, April 17th.

HOW DO I VOLUNTEER TO WORK AT THE FAIR?

Each Mercy Family is asked to work a total of 3 (THREE) Fair Hours per family. Only 1 (ONE) of those fair hours can be before or after fair hours. Our Master Fair Sign-Up will go out the week of April 17th. Grades Little Saints - 6th grade are each assigned one booth in our games/prize area. Those volunteer hours DO count toward you family's total required hours.
