ST. ANTHONY ~ POWERFUL INTERCESSOR TODAY

The Church celebrates the feast of St. Anthony of Padua on June 13th. St. Anthony, known as the "Doctor Evangelicus" is arguably one of the most popular saints in Catholicism and is venerated throughout the world, by people from other religions too. No wonder he is called "Everybody's St Anthony." Known for granting favors, he is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods. The stories of items found and credited to St. Anthony's intercession have been fascinating. People turn to him when they have lost their faith, lost hope in life, or lost a sense of purpose in life. He is great at restoring what was lost to people who pray in faith.



St. Anthony was a powerful preacher and teacher. His effectiveness as a preacher calling people back to the faith resulted in the title

"Hammer of Heretics;" just as important were his peace-making efforts and calls for justice. Pope Gregory IX spoke of Anthony as the "Ark of the Covenant" and the "Repository of Holy Scripture." That explains why St. Anthony is frequently pictured with a burning light or a book of the Scriptures in his hands. Furthermore, on account of the numerous miracles that occurred through Anthony's intercession even during his lifetime, Pope Gregory IX canonized him in 1232 only a year after his death. The richness of spiritual teaching contained in his sermons, was so great that in 1946 Pope Pius XII proclaimed Anthony a "Doctor of the Church."

The Saints are interceding for us always. Intercessory prayer is asking others to pray for us. We have sufficient biblical and theological support for this view which is well grounded in the tradition of the early Church. If St Anthony, the gentlest and kindest of saints, loved the poor and sympathized with them while he was on earth, will he forget them now that he is in heaven? He, the lover of the least and lowly, who gave back health to the sick, restored what was lost, showed tender compassion to the sorrow stricken, will he now not intercede for us who are sick, suffering, struggling, and suffocating during these dangerous and gloomy days? He who is very close to our Lord in heaven now, will he then not place our prayers and petitions before our Lord for individuals, families and those in need?

Convinced of the efficacy of the holy intercession of St. Anthony, whose heart was ever full of human sympathy, let us seek his intercession and intervention to clean up our hearts of all viruses, sanctify every family, respect life, preserve the society in unity, peace and serenity, protect those who are being tried by uncertainties of infirmity, suffering, loneliness and various other ferocious viruses. Let us work together wholeheartedly, live harmoniously with humanity and environment and experience God's healing power through our own genuine prayers and the powerful intercession of St. Anthony. St. Anthony will surely whisper our prayer into the ears of the Infant Jesus, who loved to linger in his arms. St. Anthony, pray for us.


