

Congratulations and prayerful best wishes to Fr. Charbel who celebrated his 22nd anniversary to the priesthood on July 14th.




BLESSING OF THE BACKPACKS



As you plan for your family's future needs, consider the option of cremation and burial at the Garden of Peace Memorial Columbarium.


The Mercy Columbarium Garden of Peace is open to all parishioners and non-parishioners, Catholic and non-Catholic.
