

REFLECTION ON THE IMPORTANCE OF

CATHOLIC EDUCATION

One of primary purposes of Catholic education is to assist parents in their duty to form their children in their personal faith in Christ, in their compassion and love for others, and in their hope for coming reign of God. Catholic educators know that they been successful not so much when the



see their graduates attend prestigious colleges or receive six-figure starting salaries. I consider a graduate moving toward success when he or she is developing resilience, a moral compass, and a sense of purpose.

Observers of contemporary culture have noted that more young people today show a lack of purpose in their lives. Today a smaller percentage of young men participate in the workforce. Surveys show that more young people feel a sense of isolation. It may be a sign of a lack of motivation when college students take an inordinate amount of time to complete their degrees. Some young adults continue to engage in self-destructive behavior that began in college such as excessive drinking, the use of illicit drugs, overeating, and other unhealthy habits. The prolongation of adolescence is a sign of one's failure to develop a sense of purpose. Young adults are stuck in an immature mindset when they choose pleasure without responsibility, sex without commitment, reward without responsibility, and status with-out sacrifice.

Schools and families need to start early in developing the personal qualities that help young people develop a sense of purpose in their lives. Children and adolescents respond to mentors who can show them the importance of self-disciple and high expectations. As we develop into the persons God has planned us to become, we need to set goals and priorities that are in line with our abilities and our ambitions. Frustration and fear of failure can lead us to back away from the effort needed to reach our goals. Encouragement nurtures the willingness to make sacrifices that we need to grow.

CONTINUED REFLECTION



Each of us has a responsibility to develop meaning and purpose in his or her life. Feelings of meaninglessness are the result of frustration and lack of commitment. We have duty to ourselves and our community to develop a sense of purpose which gives meaning to the sacrifices and suffering we endure.

Let us pray for the wisdom and courage to lead others as they seek to live purpose-driven lives. Let us pray for the encouragement of the Spirit that gives meaning to what we do.


