Contribution Reminder for the 2024-25 School Year: The school handbook's finance policy for contributing defines the standard



for granting an in-parish tuition rate to families who prioritize faithful participation in parish life. Those families who are registered, active and contributing parishioners will receive the in-parish tuition rate for their Catholic children. A family who makes a financial commitment to the church, giving in a regular and consistent manner, weekly or monthly, with a minimum of \$5.00 a week by December 31st, will be considered a contributing family.
