## **Campus Safety**



# JOURNEY OF FAITH PERMANENT DEACON MARK CLOUTIER

Mark Cloutier just finished his fifth year of a five-year program training for the permanent diaconate at Franciscan University, and he will be ordained a Permanent Deacon on May 25th. Bishop Duca has appointed him to Our Lady of Mercy Parish and has assigned him to the ministry of charity of serving the spiritual needs of the prisoners in the East Baton Rouge Parish Prison.

Mark credits his strong faith to his paternal grandmother, his "Grandmama," who was French Canadian and raised her family in Maine. She had a strong Catholic faith which she often shared with him. Mark discerned his calling for several years. In recent years becoming a deacon was strongly on his mind after making an ACTS retreat and serving on a couple of ACTS retreat teams. The nudge he needed was Father Cleo asking him if he had ever thought of becoming a deacon. With that affirmation, Mark applied for and was accepted into the diaconate program.

Mark was born in Illinois, but lived in many places growing up, including Omaha, Nebraska, Houston, Texas, Baton Rouge (three different times) and Iran for five years. Mark attended Kansas State University, where he graduated with a BS in mechanical engineering. He works for 1,4 Group in Geismar, on a team that is building a plant from the ground up.

Mark met his wife Lisa here in Baton Rouge through a mutual friend and they just celebrated their 27th wedding anniversary. They have two daughters, Mary, and Megan. Mark and Lisa lived in Baton Rouge for the first seven years of their marriage before moving to Macon, Georgia for thirteen years. They returned to Baton Rouge seven years ago and joined Our Lady of Mercy Parish. Upon returning, Megan attended Mercy for eighth grade and then attended St. Joseph's Academy. She is currently finishing her sophomore year at Ole Miss where she is majoring in business. Mary graduated from St. Joseph's Academy and is currently finishing her second year in the school of veterinary medicine at LSU. She married her high school sweetheart, Steven Vince two years ago.

Mark says he is delighted to be appointed to his home parish of Mercy, especially since Father Cleo was instrumental in his calling to this vocation. He is looking forward to serving our parish along with Deacons Grant and Kirk.

# THE MOST HOLY TRINITY DAILY PRAYER THIS WEEK

This is a week we can look at letting go -- of riches, honors, pride. In these Ordinary Time days we can hand it all over to Jesus and ask for the trust we need in our lives. We can hand over our fears and jealousy, our titles and our possessions - anything that has become too important in our lives can get in the way of how close we allow ourselves to be with Jesus.

As we go through our week, in the smallest moments of the day, we can beg Jesus for the strength of the Holy Spirit in our lives. As we awaken in the morning, and in the everyday moments of our lives, an awareness of our desires before Jesus can change our attitudes toward these chores and see them as sacred moments of invitation from the God who loves us with such fire and compassion.

Letting go, releasing, giving things up: it's a struggle for all of us. Perhaps we can sit for a moment with the rich young man. When he returned to Jesus looking for the easy way out, Jesus "looked at him and loved him" before he said anything else to him.

Jesus understands our deepest fears and our motivations. But despite or maybe because of that, he looks at us and loves us, endlessly not restricted in any way by our own selfishness or unwillingness to change.

Dear Lord, you know how filled I am with fears. Let each moment of anxiety today be a reminder to open my life, my heart and my soul to the love and courage you offer me. I know that if only I could trust in you more, it would change my life.

"He went away sad, for he had many possessions!" Let me turn these apprehensions over to you. I beg you to give me the wisdom and strength I need to trust more and to fear less. Teach me that it's OK to stop clinging to the fears I have known for so long and that I can embrace the freedom you offer me. Let me be less fear-full and more generous.




