# BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS

For the last fifty years, seemingly lone voices in the wilderness have warned of the death of Christian culture and the beginning of the post-Christian modern era. Since Vatican II, the Church at all levels has struggled with how to evangelize in an age that is seemingly inoculated against Christianity. Despite the temptation to despair, Ven. Fulton Sheen insisted, "These are great and wonderful days in which to be alive. ... It is not a gloomy picture - it is a picture of the Church in the midst of increasing opposition from the world. And therefore live your lives in the full consciousness of this hour of testing, and rally close to the heart of Christ" (emphasis added). Perhaps there is no more concrete example of this than that of the life of Blessed, and soon to be Saint, Carlo Acutis.

Bl. Carlo Acutis was born on May 3, 1991, in London, England, and moving shortly thereafter to Milan, Italy. His parents, Andrea Acutis and Antonia Salzano, were members of wealthy Italian families and were, by their own admission, rather lukewarm in their faith at the time of his birth. From an early age, however, Carlo demonstrated a remarkable devotion to the Eucharist and a deep love for the Blessed Virgin. At the age of five, a visiting priest from Bologna, Italy, told Carlos' mother that he would grow up to be someone special. Deeply moved by the priest's remark, Antonia describes this as the moment her life changed forever. The soon-to-be Saint and his mother began attending daily Mass together and studying theology.

Carlo, though an average student, demonstrated a keen interest in technology and computer programming. He used his skills to create a website recording Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions from around the world, describing the Eucharist as his "highway to Heaven." He freely and simply shared his joy and his faith with every person God placed in his life, all while remaining an ordinary teenager in many ways.

At age 15, however, a leukemia diagnosis turned Carlo's life upside down. Carlo embraced the redemptive nature of his suffering, however, explaining in his last words to his mother, "Mom, don't be afraid. Since Jesus became a man, death has become the passage towards life, and we don't need to flee it. Let us prepare ourselves to experience something extraordinary in the eternal life." He died on October 12, 2006, at the age of 15. His canonization was originally scheduled for April 27, 2025, but since the death of Pope Francis on April 21, 2025, his canonization has been postponed and will be declared by Francis' successor.

Bl. Carlo Acutis is truly a saint for our times. He lived his brief life simply but fully in the Heart of Christ, drawing strength from Christ's presence in the Eucharist, and never permitting himself or those around him to be discouraged by suffering or the opposition of the world. As it turns out, this simple, faith-filled living is all that is needed to evangelize in our modern age. Bl. Carlo Acutis, pray for us!





If your child does not currently attend a Catholic school, please contact Michaelyn for next steps by June 15, 2025.





## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER © DAILY PRAYER THIS WEEK

This can be a very good week to grow in a sense of and practice with the notion of being a "contemplative in the midst of action." We have almost a whole week of gospels about Jesus' gift of himself to us as the "Bread of Life." This gives us the opportunity to let that mystery be in the background of our consciousness every day this week, as we go about our everyday tasks. What makes it "contemplative" is that we will be asking for graces each morning, and we will let our desires and our activity interact.

We can begin reflecting upon how often we "work for food that perishes." The pay-off, the success, the accomplishment, the reward we receive for what we do is often quite passing and unsatisfying. It would be important to be able to sense anything that appears to be food that doesn't last and name it as such this week. The real food, the life-giving nourishment that our Lord offers us is himself.

If we can't celebrate the Eucharist daily this week, we can simply open our hearts and desire to receive our Lord, so that he remains in us and we remain in him. We can practice consciously choosing union with Jesus, our Risen Lord and only Savior, and experiencing how that would affect the choices we need to make throughout our day.

If we begin each day, asking for the grace of this union, and renew that desire at brief moments we have at various times in the day, our focus and attention begin to change. We will experience a peace and a gifted lack of hunger and thirst for so many of the things that draw us away from him, from loving, from mercy, from consciousness on those in need.

If the background focus of each day this week is to desire to be fed by a closeness with Jesus, it doesn't matter how busy I am, or how many conflicts I have to face, or what suffering I or my loved ones must endure. His flesh and blood are real food and drink because they are the real sacrifice that takes away the power of sin and death itself. United with his surrender to the Father, we are set free from whatever can take away the life he gained for us. For this gift, for this faith, we can give thanks for every night, as we review our union with our Lord each night.
